I asked two IMB missionaries to share about the ministry and needs in Japan. Below is their response

On March 28th, a little over two weeks after the horrific earthquake that rocked Japan, I was a part of a team of overseas volunteers and colleagues distributing aid near the quake's epicenter when the strongest after shock hit. At that moment my heart grieved for those who experienced the initial horror of March 11th

For this generation, Japan is forever changed. However, God's children are here "for just such a time as this" (Esther 4:14). For as we prepare to celebrate our LORD's resurrection, indeed, resurrection hope is needed.

While giving out relief supplies on the 28th of March, a young man approached me and begun to share his heart, his pain, and grief. Following the tsunami he went to where his home should have been, but found an empty lot. His mother, who was in her early fifties, and his grandfather were both swept out to sea. His is just one of the twenty –five thousand stories of those either dead or missing. Rarely will Japanese open up so quickly, but he did, and I asked, "may I pray for you?" He said, "yes, please do." God answered the prayer, for this young man felt HIS presence, HIS comfort, and HIS mercy. Our hearts, HIS presence, our pain, HIS comfort, our grief, HIS mercy, these gifts of HIS presence, comfort, mercy are what the people of Tohoku need. Please pray that they will be open to Jesus and respond to faith in HIM. Please pray for God's children in Japan to be the lights of Christ "for just such a time as this."

#### Pray for "God's will to be done in Tohoku, Kyoto & Japan as it is Heaven"

- . Pray that daily needs will be met for those in the quake zone.
- 2. Pray for wisdom for how we can best mobilize Japanese brothers and sisters o to minister, share the Gospel both in Kyoto and Tohoku, and meet the needs of those hurting.
- 3. Ask the Holy Spirit to work in Japan to bring people to Jesus, for "it is a time like this" that God can and will work for HIS glory!
