- a. Love One Another---John 13:4-35
- b. Forgive One Another—Col. 3:12-13
- c. Encourage One Another—1 Thes. 5:11; Heb. 10:23-25
- d. Comfort One Another—2 Cor. 1:3-7
- e. Pray for One Another—James 5:13-16
- f. Bear One Another's Burdens—Gal. 6:1-5
- g. Accept One Another--Roms. 14:1-7
- h. Be Truthful to One Another—Col. 3:9-11
- I. Be Subject to One Another—Eph. 5:21

Each of these could be used to develop a sermon. We are all sinners saved by the grace of God. Therefore, we have a responsibility that was left to us by the Lord Jesus Christ himself. He talked about pride, haughty spirits and jealousy. In so doing He was instructing us to be watchful and careful that these do not overtake us. How will you and I treat, react or help one another at this time of the year. During the Christmas season, everyone is ready to do that, but there are also eleven other months that a child of God may use to comfort, pray, forgive and love those around us. By this shall all men know that you are my disciples, that you have love one for another.


