Guest article from Michael Lewis, executive director of Pastors for Pastors at the NAMB states "Research indicates that ministry stress is significantly and negatively impacting pastors and their families. This negative impact has manifested in several ways.

- 50% of pastors' marriages end in divorce
- 18,000 leave the ministry every year due to burnout, termination, or moral/marital issues
- 80% of ministers' spouses with their partner would choose another profession.

Consider doing something special for the pastor who counsels families, performs marriages and funerals, visits in the hospitals and delivers God's word week in and week out as a faithful steward. 
